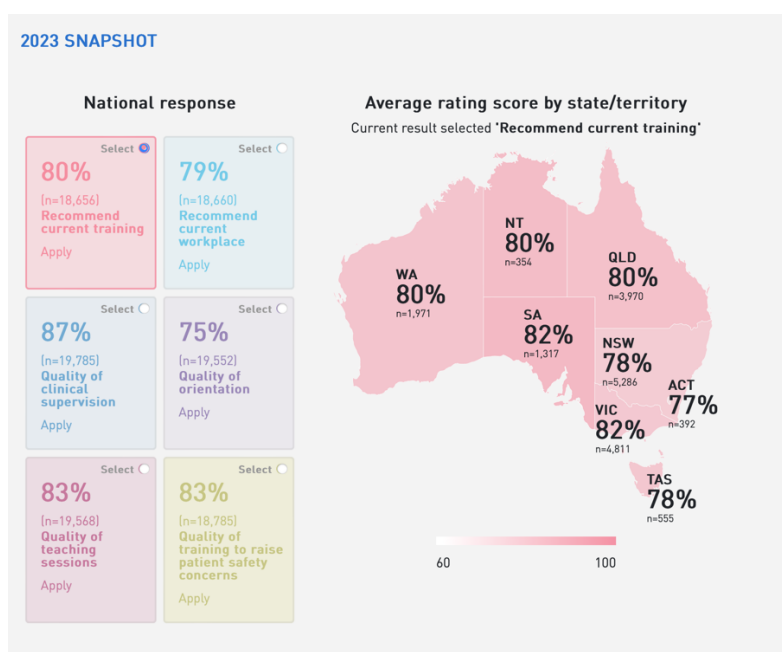


### Information from Medical Board of Australia re the Medical Training Survey for 2023

### New National Framework for Prevocational Medical Training

The Australian Medical Council (AMC) has been reviewing the National Framework and information re this is [here](#). The Framework has been implemented in 2024 in Tasmania for PGY1 (Interns) and in 2025 it shall move to also include PGY2+. The Term Descriptions for all PGY2+ terms will be reviewed in 2024 by the Postgraduate Medical Education Council Accreditation Committee (PMCT AC) to ensure that the term descriptions meet the requirements set out by the AMC.
