The PMCT Education & IMG Committee reports to the PMCT Board

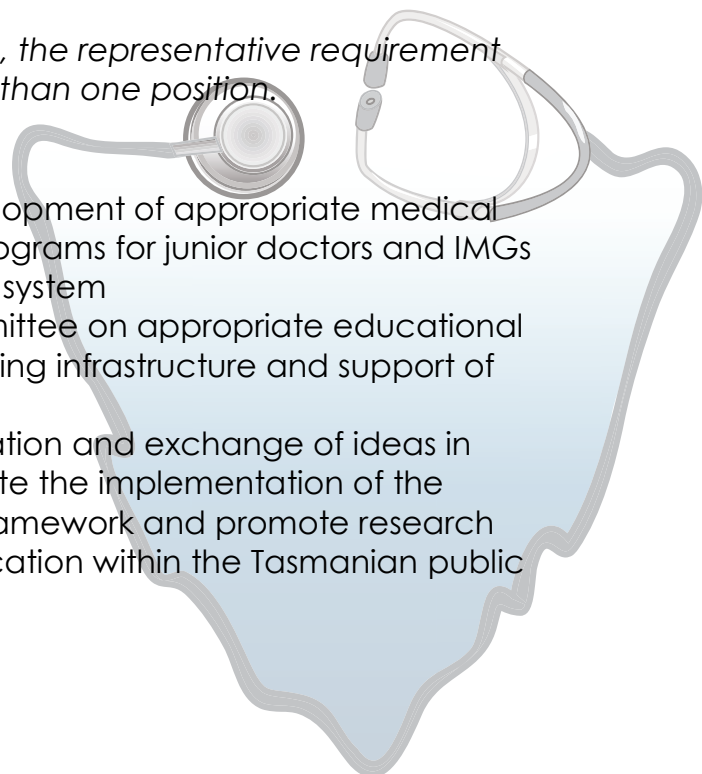

Roles & Responsibilities

- To encourage and promote the development of appropriate medical educational activities, training and programs for junior doctors and IMGs working within the Tasmanian hospital system
- Advise the PMCT Accreditation Committee on appropriate educational standards for the hospital to ensure fitting infrastructure and support of junior doctors and IMGs
- Assist with the dissemination of information and exchange of ideas in relation to medical education, facilitate the implementation of the Australian Junior Doctor Curriculum Framework and promote research along the continuum of medical education within the Tasmanian public hospital systems



- Identify and address issues affecting junior doctors and IMGs in the workplace, including issues related to registration, orientation, pre-employment interviews, education, training, Workplace Based Assessment, career development and ongoing employment
- Liaise and work with other relevant agencies and services who also manage junior doctors and IMGs eg: GPTT, APHRA
- Maintain an awareness of National initiatives which will impact on junior doctor and IMG recruitment, employment and training
